

AFSC: American Friends Service Committee
Awarded the Nobel Peace Prize in 1947

CYM: Conservative Yearly Meeting
Separate Yearly Meeting of Silent Meetings

FCNL: Friends Committee on National Legislation
Lobby organization in Washington DC
Recently a local branch was organized in NC

FDS: Friends Disaster Service
Service to people affected by disasters

FGC: Friends General Conference
Organization which serves Meetings in New England and Atlantic States

FUM: Friends United Meeting
Organization which serves Meetings in the South, West and Mid-West

FWCC: Friends World Committee for Consultation
Promotes understanding and fellowship among all branches of Quakerism

M&C: Ministry and Council
Committee of the Meeting which approves membership and worship

NCYM/Inc
Formerly North Carolina Yearly Meeting (NCYM), which has been discontinued. NCYM/Inc is composed of members from both North Carolina Friends Fellowship (NCFF) and NC Friends Church, the two groups formed when the former yearly meeting split

QLSP: Quaker Leadership Scholars Program
Guilford College Program which assisted Spring with speakers

PFF: Piedmont Friends Fellowship (and Yearly Meeting)
Organization which serves some Meetings in North Carolina

USFW: United Society of Friends Women
Charitable and Educational arm supporting Missions abroad
