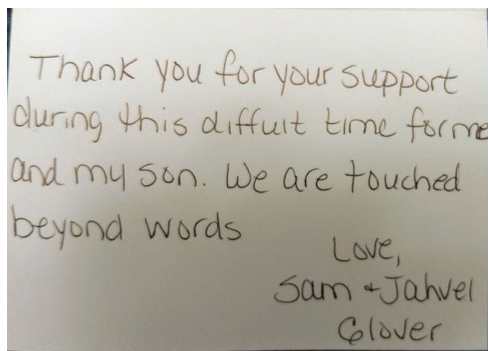
Announcements:
