Did you know that the white rocks set in concrete as the first stair into the Meetinghouse have quite a history? Those white rocks were the original steps at the front door of the Meetinghouse!

Did you know the Meetinghouse was built in 1907 and that it is the third meetinghouse on this acreage deeded by the Lindley family for Spring's Meetinghouse?

Since we are looking at the entryway, you may have heard that it took 13 years of discussion for Spring Friends to agree on the ramp to the front door. And, it was finally agreed upon and built for the October 1993 wedding of Katie Perry and Chris Nelson.
